Cross Strut

Step 1:

Unroll kite.

Step 2:

Identify struts (Diagram A).


Step 3:


Insert the Cross Strut into the Cross Strut Pockets at the leading edge of the kite (Diagram B).

Step 4:

Attach your line to the tow point (Diagram C).

Your kite is now ready to fly!





FLIGHT INSTRUCTIONS:

- -Attach flying line to Tow Loop.
- -Have a friend stand about 75 ft, downwind from you and hold the kite with its Leading Edge pointed towards the sky.
- -As the wind catches the kite, signal your friend to release it while you bring in the line with long steady pulls.
- -Slowly let out more line as the kite flies upward.
